## About the opportunity

The Poche Centre for Indigenous Health at The University of Queensland is offering data science training and internships to Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islanders at a variety of skill levels.

Our program will support successful applicants to undertake short-course external training, focused on mutual interests, and an intern-style placement within the ATLAS Indigenous Primary Care Surveillance Network team.

This will allow you to develop data science skills while working with realworld datasets. Data is sourced from Aboriginal Community-Controlled Health Organisations. (ACCHOs) as part of the ongoing national ATLAS surveillance network.

Examples of the kinds of training the ATLAS Indigenous Data Scientist capacity strengthening program would consider supporting include:

- Data literacy and analysis
- Data management
- Web design
- Programming in R
- Programming in Python
- Statistics and machine learning
- Natural language processing
- Data engineering
